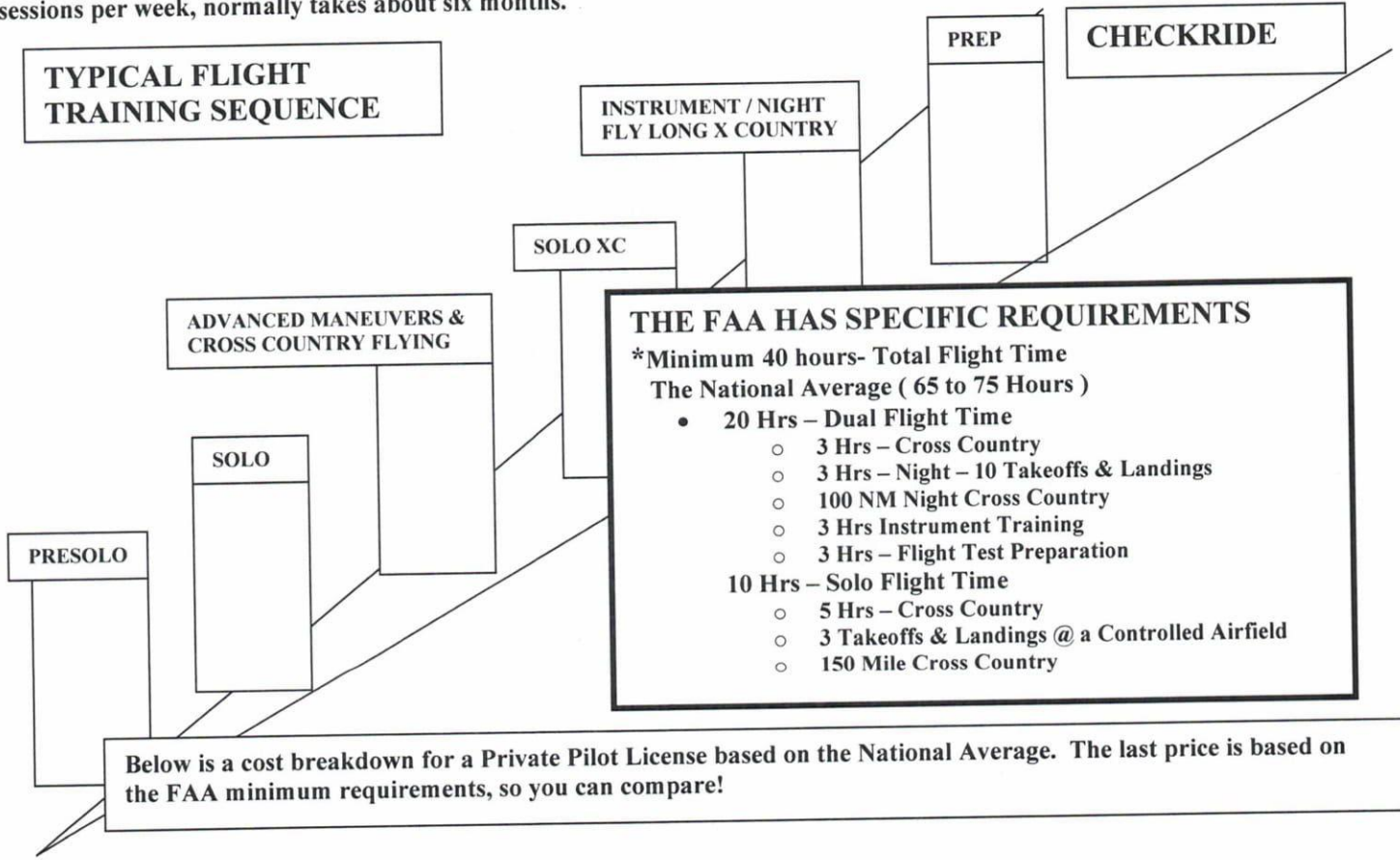

PRIVATE PILOT CERTIFICATE Rev. 02/04/2020

The Private Pilot Certificate is a lifetime accomplishment which qualifies you to fly an aircraft anywhere in the world, day or night. Once you've earned this certificate, all you need is a flight review every two years; the certificate never expires. The minimum age requirement is 17 years and you must obtain a FAA medical certificate. The course, based on 2-3 sessions per week, normally takes about six months.
